Immigrants 1870-1920

In the years since Europeans first settled North America, about 90 million immigrants have arrived—the largest migration of people in all human history Some have come to the United States for religious or political reasons, but most have come to work, or to escape problems elsewhere For example, many Irish people came because of a famine
